Town Board

The Town Board had a public hearing on the proposed Solar Law, and questions were brought up about the PILOT (payment in lieu of taxes) portion. The board voted to extend the moratorium, and send the questions back to the drafting committee.

We hope to readdress this at the September meeting.

The Supervisor sat in on the NYS mandated Sullivan County shared services board, which is composed of all town supervisors, and village managers, and the county manager. The County Manager has come up with a document that is available on the county website for review, and there will be public hearings for all interested on September 12th.

At the August meeting Assessor Dennis Ketcham informed the board that the data collection portion of the revaluation is almost totally complete. He is hoping to have the mailing with information on each parcel mailed out by the end of August. The board asked him to please expedite this, as this has been a long process, and we need to get it done. Residents are urged to carefully review this mailing for accuracy, and address any discrepancies in the allotted time frame, which will be spelled out in the mailing.

Regular Town Board Meetings are the 1st Thursday of every month, at 7pm in the Town Hall. The next scheduled meeting will be on **September 7**th. Be sure to check out the calendar on the Town's website at forestburgh.net for a list of upcoming meetings and times, and for the agenda.
