Regular Town Board Meetings are the 1st Thursday of every month, at 7pm in the Town Hall. The next scheduled meeting will be on **July 6, 2017 with a public hearing on the Comprehensive Plan at 7pm**. Planning Board

At its June 1 meeting, the Town Board appointed Anthony Cardoso to fill the empty seat on The Planning Board. Please join in welcoming Anthony and thank him for giving his time and expertise to the benefit of our town. The Planning Board's next meeting will be on **June 27, 2017** at **7pm** at Town Hall. Items on the agenda will include an application that was just received for a special use permit – and site plan review for "Another Sky Campground", to be located at 80 Tannery Road. A Sketch Plan review of a preliminary version of this project (which was then called Tent Days) was previously conducted by the Planning Board. Once the application and supporting documentation are received in a digital format (later this week) we anticipate that it will be posted on our applications page on the forestburgh.net website. The Planning Board will also conduct a review of a the proposed Local Law # 5 which seeks to amend the town code in various ways to accommodate, regulate and set fees regarding Solar Power installations in Forestburgh, and to repeal the moratorium imposed in February regarding the development of commercial scale solar power systems in Forestburgh while this new law was being drafted.
