Town Board

The monthly Forestburgh Town Board meetings are usually held the 1st Thursday of every month at 7pm in the Town Hall, located at 332 King Rd., Forestburgh. The next Town Board meeting is scheduled for **Thursday, November 7, 2019 at 7:00pm** in the Town Hall. There is a 2020 Budget Workshop scheduled for October 29th at 4:30pm in the Town Hall. We are working on and discussing ways to reduce taxes in our town. We realize the burden taxes pose on residents and are taking a hard serious look at reducing that burden while continuing to offer the same services. Planning Board

The October Planning Board meeting will take place on **Tuesday, October 22**. No applications are presently pending before the Planning Board. The Planning Board is, however, required to report to the Town Board on the proposed Local Law repealing the Zoning Code chapter authorizing Planned Development Districts (PDDs), which was enacted in 2007 to enable the Lost Lake Development.

Currently, I'm researching our town roads and their importance in commerce and passenger travel. Does anyone know about the Nancy Jones Road? It's been changed by New York State to Mill Road due to the fact one of the most productive Mills, Stokes Mill, was located there. A Historical Marker located off Mill Road tells the story. But who was Nancy Jones? Another road that has changed names many times is County Route 48 (Hartwood Road). Prior to that this road was called RFD #2 (Rural Free Delivery). This road is also a historical one. It was the original route of the Mount Hope- Lumberland Turnpike that carried lumber and tanning goods to the Delaware River in Narrowsburg. More to come....
