The regular March meeting, on the 28th, at Town Hall at 7 pm will include a continuation of the Public Hearing on an application for a two-lot subdivision by The Hartwood Club. After this public hearing is closed, the Board's consideration of this application will continue. March's meeting agenda will also include a sketch plan review of a potential application for site plan approval of a Tavern (to be named Finnegan's) at 2846 Rt 42, across the street from the Forestburgh General Store, adjacent to Forage Pizza.

Forestburgh Fire Department

The Forestburgh Fire Department is giving back with the recent semi-annual mail-out fundraiser with the purchase of 6 new Philips Heartstart automated external defibrillator, or AED. The new AED's are now placed in the four line officers vehicles, replaced one that was outdated, and equipped one on an apparatus that previously had none providing life-saving equipment to use when minutes matter most. Each AED cost approximately \$1,200 and was possible with the generous donations of our community. According to the American Red Cross, sudden cardiac arrest is among the leading causes of death in the United States. In fact, more than 350,000 people will suffer a cardiac arrest this year. Currently, the only way to restore a regular heart rhythm during cardiac arrest is to use an AED.
