Planning Board

The Planning Board held its regular June meeting. The only matter on our agenda was an application for a two-lot subdivision of a 20-acre parcel on Tannery Rd, that was formerly a part of the previously approved, but never built, Another Sky Campground brought by Big M, LLC, which bought several of the lots that were a part of the prior campsite special use permit application. The application was converted to a Land Division, and when submissions are complete, it will be reviewed according to the standards that apply to that. Our agenda for our July meeting, being held on July 23 at 7pm, will include Big M LLC's application for a land division, as well as a new application for a land division of a single 2.5-acre lot off of a 2,400-acre parcel owned by the Hartwood Club. - ◆ All pets must be in a carrier or on a leash.
- ◆ Aggressive dogs should be muzzled to prevent any biting incidents.
- ◆ Bring proof of prior rabies vaccination to receive a 3-year vaccination.
- ◆ If you do not have proof of prior rabies vaccination, your pet will receive a 1-year vaccination.

- No Pre-registration at this time, there may be pre-registration at future clinics.

Dog Control Officer

Reminder to all dog owners: by law all dogs must have current RABIES vaccinations and be licensed. Rabies and license tags must be attached to the dog's collar or harness at all times. Sullivan County offers free rabies clinics throughout the year in various locations, or your veterinarian will administer the vaccine. There has been a significant increase in abandoned dogs, dogs roaming loose and bite incidents. Letting dogs run loose is not only illegal it also creates a safety hazard for the public, the dog and other pets. Please be a responsible dog owner and a good neighbor.
