At September's Board meeting, two items were on our agenda - an application by Big M, LLC for a land division and lot improvement of a parcel on Rt 42, which was granted, and the application by Trips to Win for a Special Use permit and Site Plan review for a proposed commercial development of a lot in the RR district, on Forestburgh Rd, whose application was found to be incomplete. This application, Trips to Win, will be the sole item on October's Planning Board meeting's agenda. Reminder to all dog owners: by law all dogs must have current RABIES vaccinations and be licensed. Rabies and license tags must be attached to the dog's collar or harness at all times. Sullivan County offers free rabies clinics throughout the year in various locations, or your veterinarian will administer the vaccine. There has been a significant increase in abandoned dogs, dogs roaming loose and bite incidents. Letting dogs run loose is not only illegal it also creates a safety hazard for the public, the dog and other pets. Please be a responsible dog owner and a good neighbor.
