WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Forestburgh at the January 2025 reorganization meeting designated the Sullivan County Democrat as the official Newspaper of the Town of Forestburgh for the year 2025 and further designated the River Reporter and Times Herald Record for bidding purposes;

WHEREAS, the Town Board has determined a need to redesignate the official Newspaper and bidding Newspapers of the Town of Forestburgh for the year 2025.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board removes the designation of the Sullivan County Democrat as the official Newspaper of the Town of Forestburgh and removes the designation of River Reporter as bidding Newspaper for the year 2025.

BE IT RESOLVED the River Reporter be and is hereby designated as the official Newspaper of the Town of Forestburgh for the remaining months of the year 2025 and further to designate the Shawangunk Journal and the Times Herald Record as Newspapers for bidding purposes for the remaining months of the year 2025.
