Dog Control Officer

Reminder to all dog owners: by law all dogs must have current RABIES vaccinations and be licensed. Rabies and license tags must be attached to the dog's collar or harness at all times. Sullivan County offers free rabies clinics throughout the year in various locations, or your veterinarian will administer the vaccine. There has been a significant increase in abandoned dogs, dogs roaming loose and bite incidents. Letting dogs run loose is not only illegal it also creates a safety hazard for the public, the dog and other pets. Please be a responsible dog owner and a good neighbor.

Back in the day during the start of tourism, local residents took in guests. The Toomey 55 acre farm hosted many hunters and Vincent W. Toomey was a excellent guide for the many New York City wealthy hunters. One guest was Thomas Darlington, the head of the NYC Department of Health. He saw a young girl helping serve and tidy up after the guest and asked if she might consider becoming a Registered Nurse. A plan evolved! Mary Ellen would go down to Saint Vincent's Hospital run by the Sister's of Saint Dominic in NY City to study nursing. That's what happened and years later Margret, the youngest of the family, also followed her sister. More to come about Dr. Darlington and why he was in Forestburgh. Forestburgh Fire Company #1 has enough **File of Life** packets to supply every resident in Forestburgh and has been actively distributing them since Fall of last year; residents who have not yet received one are encouraged to stop by the firehouse on Wednesdays between 7–9 PM to pick up their packet. Any questions can be emailed to info@forestburghfire.com.**The "File of Life" program provides emergency responders with quick access to critical medical information when every second**

counts. Participants fill out a form with important details such as medical conditions, medications, allergies, emergency contacts, and doctor information. This form is placed in a visible location, on the refrigerator, and a sticker on the front door alerts responders to its presence. In an emergency, this helps firefighters and emergency medical personnel make informed decisions faster, especially if the individual is unconscious or unable to communicate.
