- 1. **Introduction of Local Law.** Local Law No. [\_\_] of 2025 entitled "Battery Energy Storage System Law of the Town of Forestburgh" is hereby introduced before the Town Board of the Town of Forestburgh, in the County of Sullivan, and shall be subject to a public hearing as set forth below.

- 4. **Referral to County Planning.** The proposed local law is hereby referred to the Sullivan County Planning Department for review pursuant to General Municipal Law § 239-m.
