## **Designating FOIL Appeal Officer**

C	ne Town of Forestburgh, Sullivan County, New York, held at stburgh, N.Y., on the 2nd day of October, 2025:

Article 6, requires that any denial of	Treedom of Information Law ("FOIL"), Public Officers Law access to records be appealable to the head, chief executive, by as may be designated (§ 89[4][a]); and

WHEREAS, § 37-8(C) of the Code of the Town of Forestburgh designates the Town Board as the body to hear appeals under FOIL; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board recognizes that the Town Supervisor, as the chief executive officer of the Town, is authorized under state law to hear FOIL appeals and desires to designate the Town Supervisor to exercise such authority on behalf of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board further desires to ratify and confirm all prior FOIL appeal determinations made by the Supervisor in such capacity;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Board of the Town of Forestburgh, Sullivan County, New York, as follows:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Town Board of the Town of Forestburgh, Sullivan County, New York, as follows:

- 1. The Town Board affirms that the Town Supervisor, as chief executive officer of the Town, is already authorized under Public Officers Law § 89(4)(a) to serve as the FOIL Appeal Officer for the Town of Forestburgh, with the authority to hear and determine all administrative appeals under FOIL, and to the extent necessary, this resolution shall constitute express designation of the Supervisor as FOIL Appeal Officer.
- 2. To the extent that § 37-8(C) of the Town Code designates the Town Board as the appeals body, the Town Board hereby delegates that designation to the Town Supervisor, consistent with FOIL, as the Town's FOIL Appeal Officer.
- 3. The Town Board hereby ratifies and confirms all prior FOIL appeal determinations rendered by the Town Supervisor, Daniel S. Hogue, Jr., on behalf of the Town.
