It is against the law for any dog to be on private property without expressed permission from the property owner or wandering loose on any public road or on any public property. Letting dogs roam loose creates a safety hazard for the dog, the public and other pets. Please be a responsible dog owner and a good neighbor.

They play a major role in the establishment of the town because back in the day they allowed the transportation of timber, blue stone and leather to get to market due to the rivers flow into the Atlantic just above the Chesapeake Bay. Town of Liberty is hosting a free rabies clinic at Hanofee Park on Thursday, August 18, 2022, from 6PM to 7:30PM. Sullivan County residents only with proof of ID required. Everyone must wear a mask and maintain social distancing guidelines while at clinic site. Appointments are required! Pre-registration is required- <https://tinyurl.com/445ks93p> Bring prior rabies certificate to receive a 3-year vaccination. With no vaccine history, receive a 1-year vaccination. All pets must be leashed or in a carrier. All pet owners **MUST** clean up after their pets! All pets must be at least 3 months old. Dogs, cats, and ferrets are welcome.
